Hours are 6:00 a.m. to 2:30 PM, Tuesdays through Saturdays, with availability, particularly on Sundays and scheduled down time. The ideal candidate will be proficient in most areas of maintenance. This position is responsible for repairs and maintenance of a moderately complex nature on a wide variety of facility plumbing, mechanical, and electrical systems.

In addition to the above, other duties of this position will be:

- Perform mechanical and/or electrical maintenance (3 Phase experience is a plus) on plant equipment to support optimum efficiency, availability, and plant appearance. This includes troubleshooting, disassembling, reassembling, replacing equipment and associated parts, monitoring plant equipment and analyzing operating date.
- Knowledge of compressors, vacuum pumps, and refrigeration systems.
- Plumbing experience/ability. Knowledge of boilers is a plus!
- Manage, monitor, and perform a Preventive Maintenance program and parts inventory.
- Interface with other managers and supervisors as needed.
- Troubleshoot and repair of equipment mechanical systems in production.
- Perform general facilities repair including plumbing, drywall, door seals, electrical, etc. Record and close-out work orders.
- Inventory and ordering of maintenance supplies and equipment, with direction from managers, coordinate service call repairs with vendors.
- Able to prioritize and perform multiple tasks to completion concurrently.
- Adhere to safety policies, maintain safety records.
- Availability for emergency call duties and weekend work. In emergency or special project situations, adjust work schedule to support production requirements.

Requirements and work experience for this position:

- Refrigeration experience and/or certification – Freeze Dryer experience a plus!
- Electrical experience, 3 phase.
- Strong mechanical aptitude.
- Strong time management, multi-tasking, and organization skills
- Highly flexible, able to adapt quickly to maintenance emergencies.
- High initiative, self-starter with a sense of urgency.
- Must possess a clear, valid WA State driver's license, current auto insurance, and a dependable vehicle.
- Must be able to read, write, and converse in the English language.
- Must be able to pass a background and drug screening.
- Must be able to work in a variety of conditions: noise, dust, heavy lifting, repetitive motion, standing for long periods of time.
- Must be able to recognize audible hazards.
- Must follow GMP, PPE, and company safety policies in performance of job duties.
